Northern Kentucky Scholar House:

A partnership project that will provide the support necessary for low-income, single parents to complete their college degree program leading to educational success, long-term employment and an ultimate goal of self-sufficiency.

In addition to Housing Assistance, connections to educational supports such as academic tutoring, financial literacy, employment assistance and access to community based services will be provided.

Additionally, as a multi-generational approach, *Scholar House* children have priority enrollment in the on-site, high quality affordable child development center.

Who is Eligible for Priority Status

- Individuals that are at least 18 years of age
- Obtained a High School Diploma or GED
- Single parent with primary custody of child/children
- Degree seeking, full time students in an approved post-secondary institution: *Gateway Community & Technical College, Northern Kentucky University, Cincinnati State, or other accredited institution upon approval*
- Maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA
- Eligible for Section 8 subsidized housing
- Eligible to have household utilities in resident's name
- Highly motivated
- Children under 5 years of age must be enrolled in the *Scholar House Child Development Center*
- Attend life skills workshops and monthly meetings with a case manager who believes in your success!
- Meet current income guidelines for both housing and childcare programs
